Almost 50% of households we serve are families with children.

SPFC has distributed **10,008 diaper packs** and **15,058 period packs** to families in need between April 2023- April 2024.

How hosting a diaper drive impacts health equity

Social determinants of health are the conditions in which people are born, grow, live, work, and age. They include factors like socioeconomic status, education, housing, employment, and access to healthcare. **Communities that adequately address social determinants of health experience health equity**, wherein no one is “disadvantaged from achieving their potential because of social position or other socially determined circumstances (CDC.gov).”

St. Pete Free Clinic’s programs support health equity for our neighbors in need by providing access to nutritious food, healthcare, and housing for those experiencing housing insecurity and substance use challenges.
