# 2024 ANNUAL SNAPSHOT

#### JARED'S FOOD BANK

- **20.4 Million pounds of food** distributed throughout Pinellas County to over 115 partner sites including schools, churches, and other non-profits.
- **\$47 Million in household grocery savings** provided to the community.
- FRESH Rating of 74%. Meaning 74% of what people took home was fresh protein, dairy, eggs, and bread.

#### WE HELP SERVICES

- 477,999 visits for free groceries provided by the We Help FRESH Pantry.
- **66,500 students and families** served through offsite youth-focused pantries and programs.
- **3,200 seniors** provided free groceries at convenient congregate meal sites.
- 2,635 communication navigation services provided.

#### **HEALTH & DENTAL CENTERS**

- \$6 Million in healthcare services delivered.
- 16,200 patient encounters provided for 2,000
  patients, with each patient receiving an average of
  8 services (including primary care, specialist
  services, dental care, diabetes intervention services,
  prescription medications, and medical/healthcare
  navigation).
- 76% of patients who needed services besides primary care received access to healthcare they would otherwise not have received.
- 97% of patients reported satisfaction with the care they received at SPFC's Health Center.

## **RESIDENCES**

• **169 women and men** in recovery from substance use were housed with 29 graduating and moving on to permanent housing.

## **VOLUNTEERS**

- **716 volunteers** contributed **45,865** hours of service across SPFC programs.
- \$1.5 Million of volunteer time contributed to SPFC.






